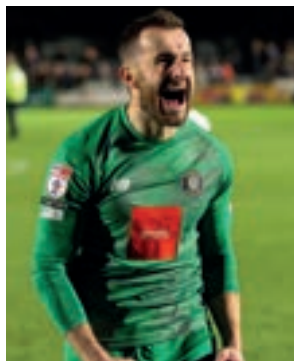

Good afternoon everyone and a happy new year to you and your loved ones!

Welcome to today's local derby against Doncaster, after a packed Christmas period with some exciting games I hope you have enjoyed the festive period.

As the Hall of Fame takes shape within the ground I encourage you all to go and have a look at the displays. Bernard Higgins has played a vital role in setting up the Hall of fame and has driven the project to where it is today. Please see below from Bernard

The Harrogate Town AFC Hall of Fame was established in May 2022 to celebrate those individuals who have made significant contributions to the football club since it was formed in 1914.

With the support of Chairman Irving Weaver, Manager Simon Weaver, CEO Sarah Barry and Fan Engagement Manager Hamilton Mattock the Hall of Fame idea has gone from strength to strength. The Hall of Fame committee meet once a month and include representatives from the Independent Supporters Club, the Football Club's Community Foundation, the club Historian, long term supporters and staff at the club.

The Hall of Fame Launch took place at the Cedar Court Hotel on February 9th 2023 and turned out to be a night to remember. Eleven individuals who have played significant roles at the club over many years were selected by the Hall of Fame Committee with the 12th man, Danny Holland being selected by the supporters.

Many thanks were extended to the Cedar Court Hotel owners and management for donating the large wooden frame with downlighting which accommodates the fantastic A3 Perspex frames that display the image and information of each inductee.

There were originally four venues identified as being suitable for displaying the Harrogate Town AFC Hall of Fame :

They include :

- The Cedar Court Hotel
- The EnviroVent Supporters Bar
- The Hospitality Suite
- The Club Shop in Commercial Street



One other area has since been identified as being suitable as the fifth venue and the club are delighted to announce that the Marquee/Supporters Bar will have an area dedicated to the Hall of Fame members.

Many thanks to club Historian Phil Harrison for researching the input that each prospective inductee has made since the football club was formed and to Rich Saltmarsh for producing the final images and information on each inductee. The installation of each inductee's image and information at each venue is down to Mark Rowley, the club's Facilities Manager.

Many thanks to Mark, Phil and Rich for finding the time in their busy schedules to set up the Hall of Fame venues.

In the last few weeks the second Hall of Fame venue was unveiled at the EnviroVent Supporters Bar before the Swindon match on Saturday 16th November. Members of the Hall of Fame Committee were in attendance and are looking forward to the remaining venues being unveiled in the next few weeks.

The football club's website has access to the Hall of Fame FAQ's information. Supporters and any other interested party can view how the Hall of Fame committee make any decisions.

It was decided at an early stage with advise from other football clubs that there would be three new inductees added to the original Hall of Fame members. This selection format will make sure that no one who deserves to be selected to the Harrogate Town AFC Hall of Fame due to their dedicated service over many years will be forgotten.

The three latest inductees to the Hall of Fame are Ernest Baines (1919-28), Bob Morphet (1920's) and Dave Merris (1999-2014). The Baines and Morphet families and Dave Merris have indicated they are delighted and proud to be invited to join the Harrogate Town AFC Hall of Fame.

Formal letters have been sent confirming the selection to join the Hall of Fame and the three latest members of the Hall of Fame will be inducted in February 2024.

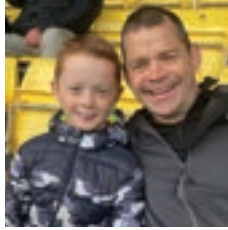

SATURDAY 12 JANUARY 2002

We go back 22 years to a big game in Town's history against Doncaster. This was our first ever meeting with Rovers a first game against a side recently out of the EFL (1997/98) so everyone wanted to go to the match.

Rovers under new acting manager Dave Penney since 1 January were now a Conference side and Town under John Reed, played in the Northern Premier League (Unibond) Division One, two levels below.

The game was an FA Umbro Trophy tie and after defeating Colwyn Bay 2-0 and Kendal Town 2-1, Town were rewarded with a Third Round trip

to Doncaster Rovers' Belle Vue on Saturday 12 January 2002. 300 Town fans travelled and the supporters club (yours truly) sent three coaches.

The match attracted a crowd of 1,886 and was a great day out despite Town losing 2-0 in a very close game as it turned out. Scorers for Doncaster were Neil Campbell and former Town player Andy Watson (1987/88).

Town finished the season as Champions of NPL Division One promoted to the Premier league and Doncaster finished fourth in Conference league. Top scorer for Town with 28 league and cup goals was captain Robbie Whellans and for Doncaster Jamie Paterson scored 16.

The next time we met was in League Two last season. The first fixture was on 7th March 2023 at the Keepmoat Stadium and Town came away with a 2-0 win with goals from Luke Armstrong and Alex Pattison. The return fixture at The EnviroVent Stadium on 15 April ended in a 2-2 draw. Trailing with goals from Aidan Barlow and Luke Molyneux, Town replied with second half goals from Luke Armstrong and Tom Eastman in front of a 3,014 crowd.

We did of course play at their Keepmoat Stadium for the first three home games of our debut 2020/21 EFL season whilst our newly laid grass pitch needed time to settle.

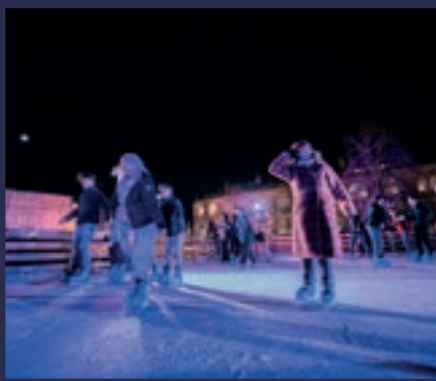

Doncaster Rovers appointed Grant McCann for a second spell as manager in May 2023, the 43-year-old replacing Danny Schofield who was relieved of his duties after Rovers finished 18th in League Two last season.

McCann first managed Rovers in the 2018-19 campaign and guided them to the League One play-offs before leaving to take over at Hull City, who he led to the League One title.

McCann was relieved of his duties by the Tigers in January 2022 and spent a year in charge of Peterborough before leaving in January 2023 despite The Posh being eighth in League One, three points off the play-off positions.

A former Northern Ireland international, earning 39 caps, McCann had a career that saw him play over 500 league games starting at West Ham before moving to Cheltenham, Barnsley, Scunthorpe and Peterborough United.

24-year-old defender, Olowu joined the Arsenal Academy at the age of eight and had spells at Cork and Wealdstone before being released by the Gunners. He initially arrived at then League One Rovers on a trial basis in September 2021 after leaving The Emirates and earned himself a short term contract which has since been extended after catching the eye with his performances at the heart of defence.

Bailey came through the ranks at Newcastle United.

Gambian born youngster Mo Faal joined Rovers on a season-long loan from West Bromwich Albion. The 20-year-old, who stands at 6ft 5ins, has made a handful of senior appearances for the Baggies making his debut in 2021 and has also gained senior experience out on loan in non-league football with Hereford, AFC Telford United and AFC Fylde where he scored 10 goals in 16 appearances last term.

The experienced forward joined Rovers over the Summer after leaving Cambridge United where he played a key role in their promotion to, and survival in, Sky Bet League One in recent seasons.

The 30-year-old said netted 35 goals in 145 appearances for Cambridge. He scored 14 goals during the promotion-winning campaign of 2020/21 before beating the tally the following season in League One and also netted the only goal of a brilliant FA Cup upset at Newcastle United. Born in Middlesbrough but raised in South Yorkshire, he came through the ranks at Sheffield United, for whom he made 23 senior appearances before a spell in non-league football. Returning to the EFL with Macclesfield Town in 2019, he made the switch to Cambridge a year later.

Driving Directions: When planning a trip here, look up Nailsworth, south of Stroud. The best way to approach is from the M5 and exit at junction 13 and head for Stroud on the A419. At Stroud turn onto the A46 towards Nailsworth. This will bring you into the centre of the town - take a right at the mini roundabout into Spring Hill, which goes up a steep hill signposted Forest Green. The New Lawn is at the top of this hill. Turn left at the roundabout at the 'summit' into the stadium entrance. There is no parking available in the club car park but there is plenty of on-street

parking in the area, although please be considerate to local residents.

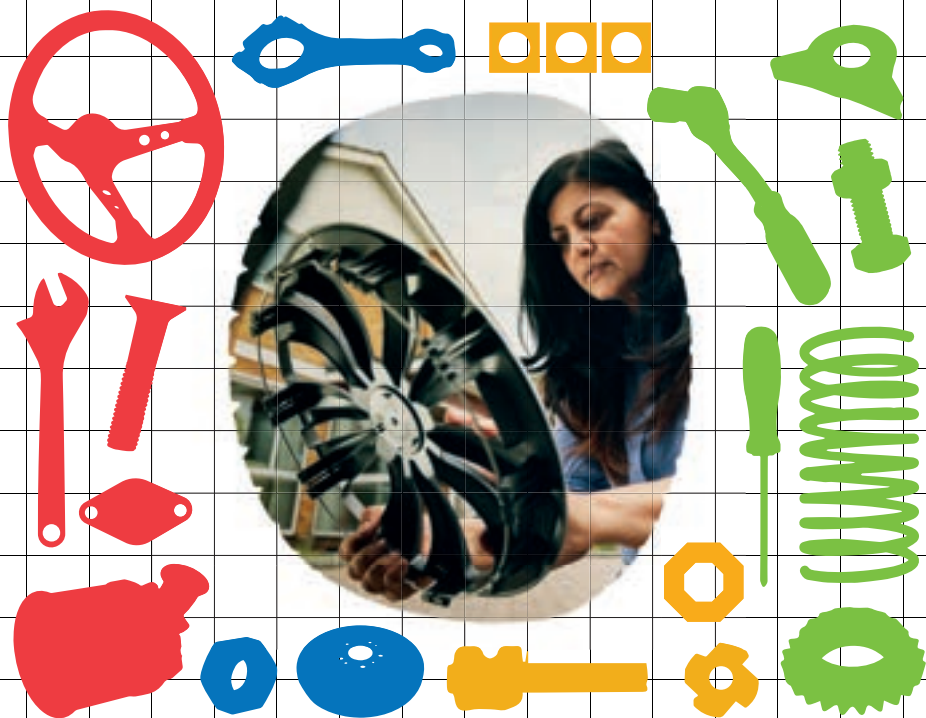
